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
Current REPRC Activity

 - Therapy: 10
 - Diagnostic Imaging: 0

CAMPEP REPRC

- manage the initial accreditation and re-accreditation of residency programs
- assign a survey team which consists of senior medical physicists with experience in both clinical physics practice and education programs
 - ✓ volunteer basis – 70 volunteers for program self-study reviews and site visits (14 imaging, 11 physician reviewers)
 - ✓ Length of review process – 6 months to year

 - ✓ Left to Take Job: 6
 - ✓ Decided Medical Physics not a Good Match: 1
